Since 2005, she has participated in six Conference of Parties ("COP") meetings of the 197 countries who are signers to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change. This year J. met with Special Presidential Envoy for Climate John Kerry, who shared his insights into his diplomatic work with the G20 nations. In Glasgow, she brought Midwesterners to the global stage to discuss The Vital Importance of Rapid Decarbonization in the American Midwest. Hamilton was quoted from Glasgow in the Star Tribune, on Minnesota Public Radio, and on KARE11 TV news.
